# Goals

1. Gain official acknowledgement from MT Legislature, Governor Gianforte, MT Society of Veterinarians, MT Dept. of Livestock, AVMA, etc. that cattle mutilations are a *separate and distinct subclass* of livestock predation.
2. Require that every case discovered be a reportable animal death.
3. Establish where, when, and (if possible) why this is happening!
4. Establish a MT compensation program to reimburse ranchers for financial losses. Establish standards of evidence.
5. Establish a MT task force of volunteers. **Mission:** determine why these events are happening and *if they can be prevented*.
6. Establish guidelines for handling / disposal of carcasses?

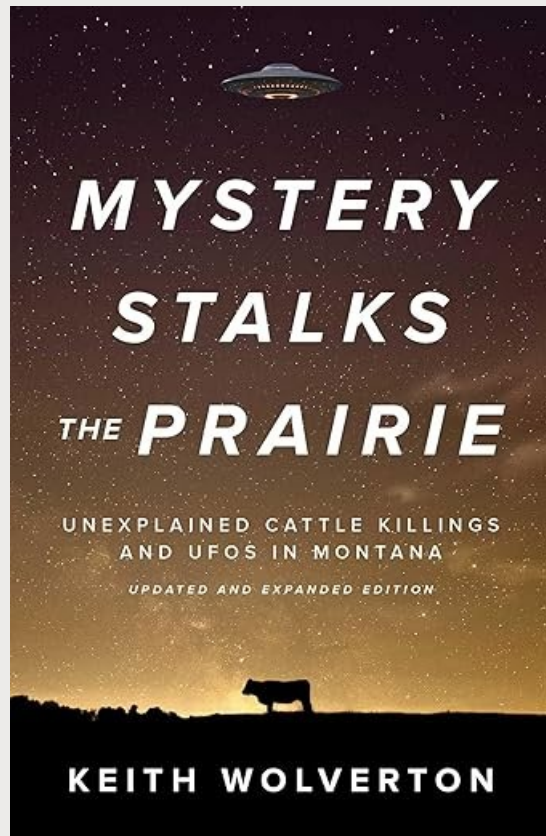

 The cyanide test is requested to rule out cyanide poisoning, realizing this is a long shot but should be done to cover all bases.  
 The serum copper is requested due to one report of depleted serum copper in a similarly mutilated cow from years ago.  
 This "cattle mutilation" phenomenon is ongoing here in Montana (I saw another one of these in Teton County on a mature Angus bull about a year ago) and these have also been reported in Colorado, New Mexico, Missouri, and even Argentina.  
 The excisions on these animals are surgical in appearance and definitely not the work of scavengers or predators. I can send photos if anyone there is interested. RKO.

- Dead < 24 hours
- Typical physical findings
- GCMS: no pharmaceuticals, no poisons
- Anthrax culture negative
- Upon death, hepatic metabolism quickly stops. Drugs should be there – but are not found

# Facts

- Numbers of cases: Unknown. At least 100s. Probably thousands
- Physical findings are stereotypical from case to case
- They are deliberately done in such a way as to be easily recognizable, even from a short distance
- Hundreds of forensic investigations by sheriffs, DoL inspectors, and FBI have essentially ruled out the perpetrators being wolves, bear, mountain lions, coyotes, and humans
- Due to an +/- 80 year UFO cover-up, Aliens / Extraterrestrials / Non-Human Intelligence (NHI) have been effectively excluded from the list of possible perpetrators

# Cattle Mutilations: physical findings are *stereotypical*

Classic excision. Note serrations; tongue cleanly transected and cauterized



Along caudal spine, 3 curious square or stellate piercings were not bullet holes.



# Different combinations of findings

- Often - face plate excised
- +/- serrated wound margins
- +/- ground depressions +/- long-bone or pelvic fractures – as if dropped from a height
- +/- total body exanguination
- Often -tongues cleanly transected and cauterized
- Often - one ear cleanly removed
- +/- discovered in strange body positions (head in a post hole)
- +/- fetuses removed and absent
- Often scrotum removed
- Often penis & testicles removed
- Often - teats or entire udder removed
- +/- dew claw removed
- Often - circles or squares of hide removed leaving underlying fascia intact
- Often -eye enucleated +/- a band of surrounding hide removed.
- Often – anus, rectum, vulva removed
- +/- heart absent w/ intact pericardium!

Wound edges are sharp, apparently cauterized, and no tearing

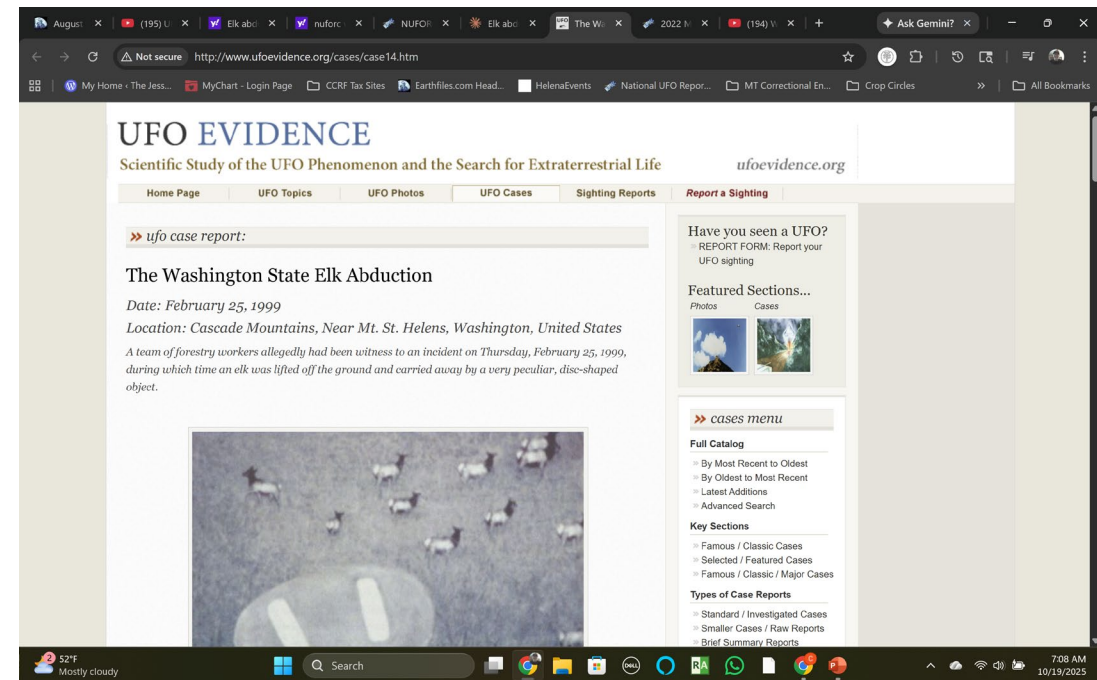
In this case, no serrations are apparent

Underlying fascia is completely intact and untouched

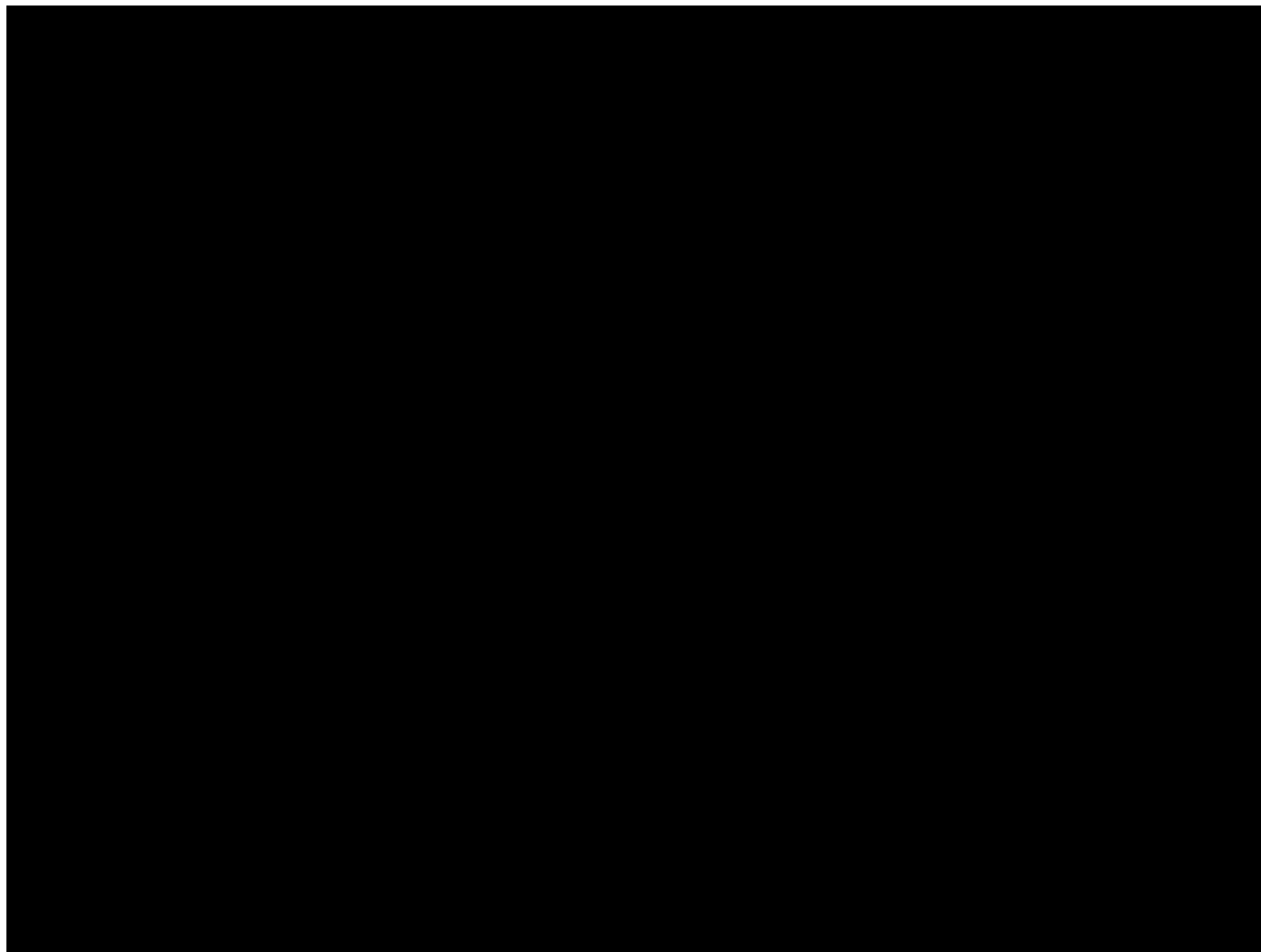
# Elk Abduction February 25, 1999

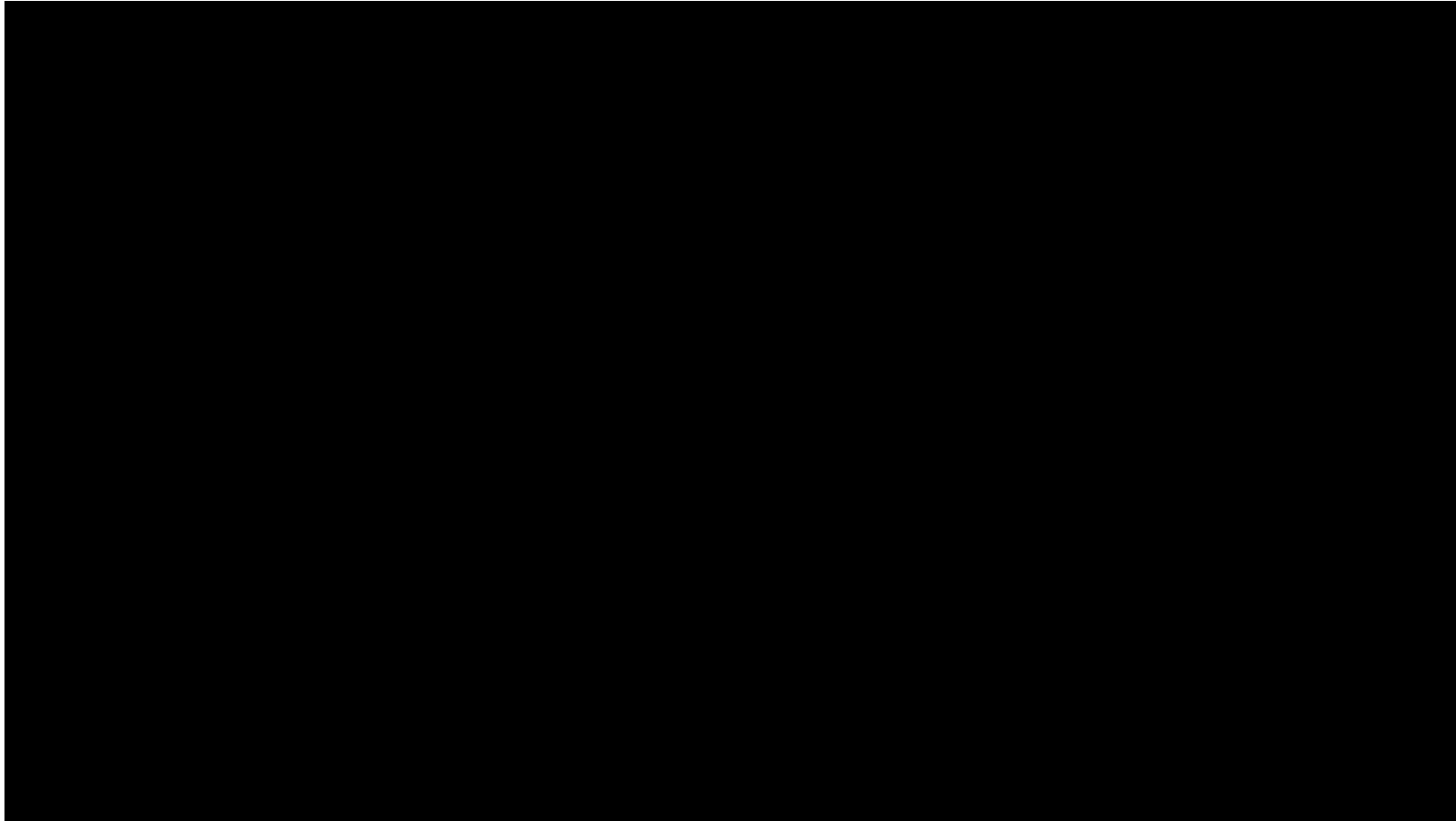

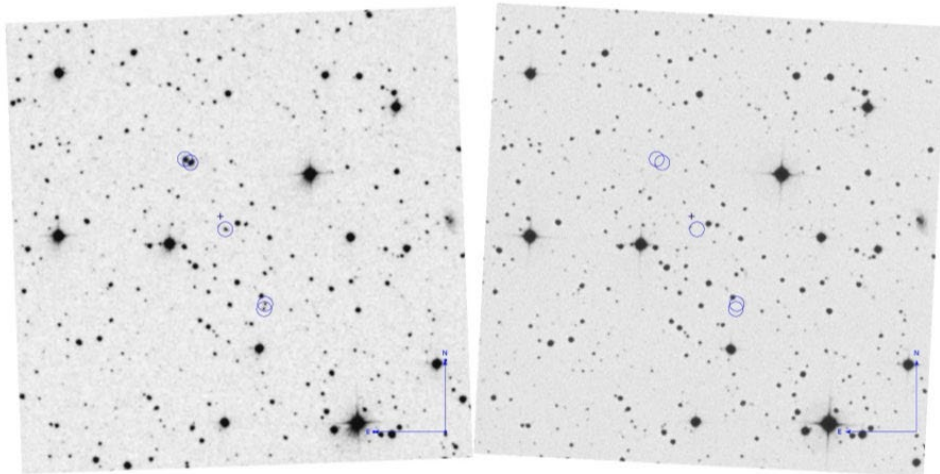

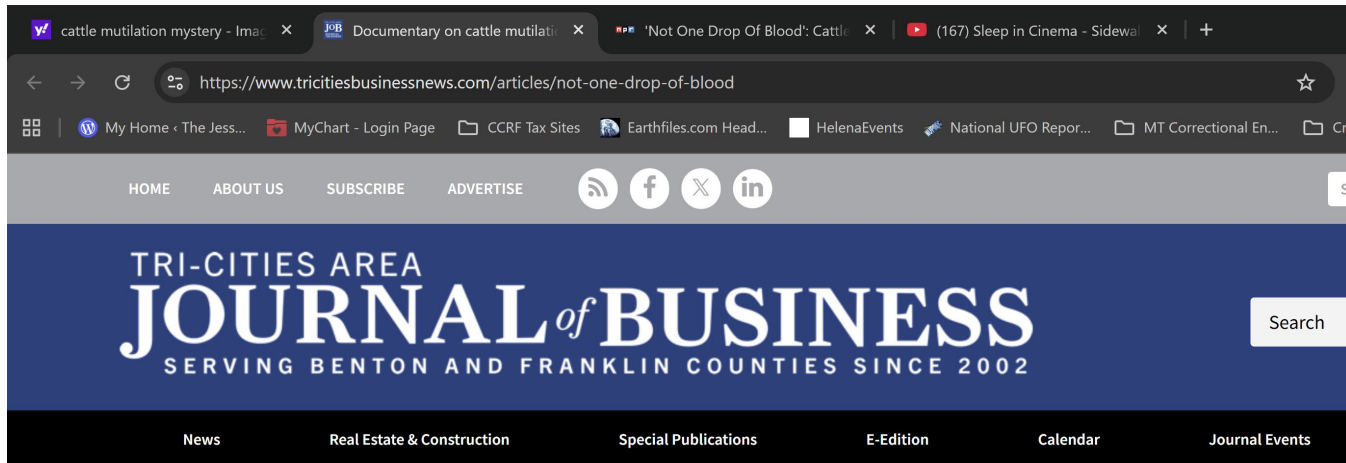
- **Pre-Sputnik**  $3.9 \sigma$  alignments of multiple point light sources (large metallic objects reflecting sunlight 30,000 km above Earth)
- None recorded in Earth's shadow ( $22 \sigma$ )
- Implication: UFOs in Earth orbit
- Gatherings coincident with UFO sightings above Washington, D.C. in July 1952
- ***Gatherings coincident with above ground nuclear tests!!***

# Not Love Letters

- The level of malice and violence is extreme, bordering on absurd.
- Are CMs intended as a message (like a head on a pike)?
- If so, what is the message?
- “If we can do this to a large, powerful animal in an open pasture, we can do it to you as well.”
- But they haven’t – so far.
- Many cases in MT occur near ICBM missile fields!
- Aliens / ETs have disabled our nuclear missiles “dozens of times”!
- **Important question** – are these CM messages tied to warnings about nuclear weapons?

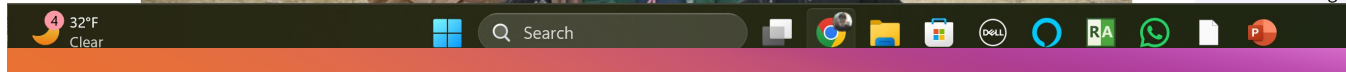

# Conclusions

- Perpetrators of genuine CMs are a non-human intelligence.
- Mutilations are *intended to be discovered and recognized* by their stereotypical appearance.
- Mutilations are intended to invoke shock and horror.
- Mutilations focus on cattle, implicating an important link in our food supply.
- Mutilations focus on reproductive organs. This may reference the continuity of life.
- Mutilations near missile fields accompany long-standing warnings from NHI about our nuclear weapons.

# Goals

1. **First and foremost: remove the stigma!!!**
2. Gain official acknowledgement from MT Legislature, Governor Gianforte, MT Society of Veterinarians, MT Dept. of Livestock, AVMA, etc. that cattle mutilations are a *separate and distinct subclass* of livestock predation.
3. Require that every case discovered be a reportable “illness”.
4. Establish a MT state-run compensation program to reimburse ranchers a standardized amount for a loss due to mutilation.
5. Establish a MT task force of volunteers. **Mission:** determine why these events are happening and if they can be prevented.
6. Establish guidelines for handling / disposal of carcasses?

# Suggestions

1. Station a small herd next to every nuclear missile installation in Montana and see what happens?
2. Establish compensation criteria: a narrative report, supporting photos, a frozen blood sample for GCMS on animals discovered < 48 hours post-mortem. No drugs = not humans.
3. As ours was the the first and only country to use a nuclear weapon, we can and should begin a discussion about an international agreement to ban nuclear weapons.
4. There is reason to hope that this initiative will bring a stop to cattle mutilations.

For cattle mutilations,  
add aliens / ETs to the list of usual suspects!  
They are the prime suspects!
